



Our Vision

At Mission Viejo Christian School we are passionate about:

Facts and Fees

Mission Viejo Christian School was founded in 1993 with 48 students. In 2012 we moved our elementary and junior high school to our current 11-acre campus featuring multiple playgrounds, sport court, an expansive 5-acre field, and spacious classrooms. Our growing student body is currently near capacity with approximately 520 students in grades K-8. Preschool classes are offered at the Mission Viejo Christian Preschool campus located less than a mile away on the Mission Viejo Christian Church site.

Church Affiliation

• MVCS is a ministry of Mission Viejo Christian Church. While several of our school families attend MVCC, our student body is made up of Christians from many churches.

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Application Fee

A \$100 non-refundable application fee is required and payable online at the time an application is submitted. Application and fee may be rolled over to the following school year upon request by parent if applicant has been accepted to our waitlist and space does not become available.

Annual Enrollment Fee

- The Enrollment Fee for new students and automatic Re-enrollment Fee for returning students of \$400 per child is due at the time of enrollment each year.
- Payment of this fee implies intent to attend and is non-refundable as it directs staffing and purchasing decisions.

One-Time Technology Fee: \$400

 A one-time Technology Fee covers costs related to the personal chromebook required for each incoming student in Grades 6-8. Chromebook purchase is also available for Grade 5, but not required.
 Fee Includes new chromebook, warranty, safeguards, limited maintenance, IT services through graduation

Tuition Discount

- After the first child in a family, each sibling receives a 10% tuition discount
- An additional 10% discount is given to members of Mission Viejo Christian Church to students
- Discounts are also offered to students whose parents are full time senior pastors and primary provider for the household or actively serve in the military full-time.
- Mission Viejo Christian Preschool families receive a 10% multiple sibling discount if they have a student attending our elementary/junior high campus.
- No discount is available for pre-paid tuition.

Academics

Mission Viejo Christian School believes that in order for children to thrive and reach their greatest Godgiven potential, we must nurture the whole child. Students at MVCS are immersed in a challenging academic curriculum integrated with biblical principles that lead to a biblical worldview. We foster an environment that is supportive, loving, and encouraging. Small classes are taught by credentialed, godly teachers who instill a love for learning and care for each individual student. Standardized test results, high school placements, and academic competitions confirm we are preparing academically successful graduates who are spiritually equipped to fulfill God's plan for their lives.

Core Academic Curriculum

- We ensure the preparation of 21st century learners by focusing on the development of critical thinking skills, collaboration, creativity, and communication.
- The following Core Academic Subjects are taught in grades K-8:
 - Bible, English/Language Arts, Math, History and Science
 - 1:1 Chromebook Program: Grades 4-8
 - 1:1 Chromebook Program: Grades K-3 (Available in all classes on a rotation basis)

Enrichment Courses

- We believe that a well-rounded education includes learning that inspires creativity, promotes understanding, develops leadership, and explores our students' unique gifts and talents.
- The following enrichments are taught by specialized teachers who share their passion and expertise:
 - Music, PE, Art, Library, STEM: Grades K-6
 - Band or Choir: Grades 5-6
 - Spanish: Grades 7-8
 - Elective classes: Grades 7-8
- Junior High offers a variety of high quality electives that may include:

Worship band, rocketry, robotics, leadership, computer coding, 3D printing, drama/musical theater, ukelele, photography, art/mixed media, life skills, money management/career readiness and more

STEM-Based Learning (Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics)

- Technology-Rich Environment: Technology is integrated in every classroom and throughout the learning process, utilizing Smartboards, chromebooks and online resources.
- Digital Citizenship: Students are trained in the responsible use of technology through which they can advance God's kingdom. Emphasis is placed on the safe and secure use of digital devices and online resources as students learn to operate effectively in a digitally focused world.
- Hands-On Science: In our dedicated STEM lab, elementary and jr. high students collaborate and problem-solve as they discover and investigate their world through hands-on activities and experiments.

Programs

Mission Viejo Christian School believes that "the extras" are an integral part of what makes our school special. Enriching our core academic program with activities and opportunities enables our students to be successful in and out of the classroom, as well as to cultivate areas of particular interest.

Spiritual Development

Chapel: Engaging weekly chapels promote spiritual depth as students learn to know and experience God in a personal way. Worship, prayer, guest speakers, and biblical lessons make up the heart of chapel time. Parents and special guests are welcome to attend and participate with our school family as we worship together.

Missions: Building servant leaders can only happen when students are given opportunities to serve and to lead. Each year MVCS staff and students lift up others in need through action and prayer in their classes and through school mission projects. Our students have brought joy and love to cancer patients, needy families, disabled children, senior centers, homeless shelters, veterans and military groups, and orphans in Uganda, Haiti, Congo, Mexico, and Dominican Republic. Our 2021-22 school wide focus supporting the Free Wheelchair Mission brings students and STEM learning together to be the hands and feet of Jesus.

Baptism: Each spring, our students in grades 7-8 learn about the inward and outward significance of baptism. They are given an opportunity to be baptized at Mission Viejo Christian Church with families and friends cheering them on. This is a day that will touch your heart.

Field Trips: MVCS field trips enrich and expand upon classroom instruction. They open students' eyes to the world around them, broaden their perspectives, and provide hands-on learning. The cost of 2-3 field trips per year is included in tuition, with the exception of overnight trips listed below, which are annual favorites:

1. Tour our Campus

We invite you to explore our beautiful 11-acre campus where you will visit classrooms, meet teachers along the way and see the school in action. In addition to our expansive playgrounds, 5-acre sports field and sport court, you will visit our STEM lab, performing arts room, foreign language classroom and art studio.

Join us to learn more about the application process and hear about all we have to offer.

2. Application

Please complete and submit the online Application on our website at missionviejochristian.com, including the \$100 non-refundable application fee. Fall 2024-25 applications submitted **December 1-January 15** will be reviewed in February and families will be notified of acceptance at the end of February.

Applications may also be submitted year round with students accepted for available space or our wait pool.

The following supplemental documents must accompany each application

- Copy of certified birth certificate
- Immunization records
- Report cards (current and previous year)
- Teacher Reference and Family Reference contact name and email (grades K-8)
- Standardized achievement test results (previous two years)
- Individual and Family photo (for identification purposes)

3. Assessment

An age-appropriate assessment, administered by school faculty, will be given to students entering grades 1-8, as needed. Chancy and Bruce Educational Resources provides the assessment for our incoming Kindergarten students.

4. Family Interview

Once these steps are complete, the Admissions office may schedule a Family Interview for the applicant and parents/guardians to meet our Elementary or Jr. High Principal and get to know one another better. This is a great opportunity for you to ask questions and learn more about us, as well.

5. Acceptance

The Admissions Committee will evaluate each applicant's file and notify parents by email regarding acceptance.

6. Enrollment

Upon acceptance, our business office will contact you with instructions to complete the online enrollment in order to secure your child's placement.
